1. The Competition will be held under ASA laws and Technical Rules.
2. The Meet will be held under the one start rule with rollover starts
3. All entrants must be members of an affiliated club and must be ASA registered.
4. Ages are as the day of the Gala, except the 9 years age group, where swimmers will be born between the 25th May 1999 and the 31st December 2000.
5. Competitors may only enter events in their own age group and in the name of one club.
6. No entries will be accepted after the closing date.
7. Entry fee £3.50 per event.
8. The Promoters may limit the entries, which will be on a 'first come first served' basis.
9. Once an entry has been accepted by the promoters there will be no refund.
10. Coach passes are £6.00, to include program and results sheets, and must be applied for before the closing date.
11. Winners will be heat declared.
12. Awards for first six in each age group. Any competitor disqualified will not receive an award.
13. Award for Top boy and girl in each age group.
Points scoring will be: 1st=6 pts; 2nd=5 pts; 3rd=4pts, 4th=3pts; 5th=2 pts; 6th=1pt.
In the event of a tie, a count back on the number of 1st places, 2nd places etc. will occur to determine the winner.
14. Coaches or swimmers to collect their cards from a desk and report with their cards to the stewards, two events prior to their event.
15. Any competitor failing to report on time may be excluded from the event.
16. Entry cards to be posted 40 minutes before the start of each session.
17. The pool area will be cleared between sessions.
18. No person will be allowed on poolside without a pass.
19. Entrance charges: £2.50 per session, £1.00 children and OAP'S. All day program £1.00
20. Any person wishing to use still or video cameras must register at the entry desk.
21. Results sheets will be available at 20p each.
22. No glass bottles on poolside.
23. Anything not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the promoters.
24. The promoters' decision relating to the interpretation of these conditions will be final.
